### Article 9 - National implementation measures

Swiss law [514.51 Federal Act on War Material of 13 December 1996](#) that includes penal sanctions as required by the CCM is applicable in Liechtenstein

Amended [Liechtenstein Law on Brokering in War Material](#) in 2013 to include prohibitions on brokering and direct/indirect financing of cluster munitions
