## **DUBLIN 19 – 30 MAY 2008**

## Proposal by Ireland for the amendment of Article 1

- 1. Each State Party undertakes never under any circumstances to:
  - a) Use cluster munitions;
  - b) Develop, produce, otherwise acquire, stockpile, retain or transfer to anyone, directly or indirectly, cluster munitions;
  - c) Assist, encourage or induce anyone to engage in any activity prohibited to a State Party under this Convention.

## 2. Dispensers, affixed to an aerial platform and designed to disperse or release explosive bomblets, are subject to the same provisions as cluster munitions

<u>3</u>. This Convention does not apply to mines as defined in the Protocol on Prohibitions or Restrictions on the Use of Mines, Booby-Traps and Other Devices, as amended on 3 May 1996, annexed to the Convention on Prohibitions or Restrictions on the Use of Certain Conventional Weapons Which May Be Deemed to Be Excessively Injurious or to Have Indiscriminate Effects.
