Proposal by the United Kingdom for the amendment of Article 5

- 1. Each State Party with respect to cluster munitions victims <u>injured in its own</u> <u>territory</u> shall, <u>in accordance with national laws and practices</u>, provide for their medical care <u>and treatment</u>. Each State Party shall make every effort to collect reliable relevant data with respect to victims of cluster munitions.
- 2. In fulfilling its obligation under paragraph 1 of this Article each State Party shall <u>ensure that the measures adopted are in accordance with fundamental human rights principles, including non-discrimination</u>, and shall take into consideration relevant guidelines and good practices in the areas of medical care <u>and treatment</u>.
