Proposal by Canada for the amendment of Article 2

For the purposes of this Convention:

(...)

"Cluster munition" means a munition that is designed to disperse or release explosive sub-munitions, and includes those explosive sub-munitions. It does not mean the following:

- (a) a munition or sub-munition designed to dispense flares, smoke, pyrotechnics, or chaff;
- (b) a munition or sub-munition designed to produce electrical or electronic effects;
- (c) <u>a munition that has all the following characteristics that ensure</u> <u>greater accuracy and reduce the risk of unexploded ordnance</u> <u>contamination from its use:</u>
 - (i) <u>each sub-munition is designed to locate and engage a point</u> <u>target within a pre-defined area;</u>
 - (ii) <u>each sub-munition is equipped with an electronic self-destruct</u> mechanism;
 - (iii) <u>each sub-munition is equipped with an electronic self-</u> <u>deactivation mechanism.</u>
