

Invitation to the Intersessional Meeting 2012 Convention on Cluster Munitions

Geneva, 9 March, 2012

Excellency,

On behalf of the President of the Second Meeting of States Parties to the Convention on Cluster Munitions (CCM 2MSP) H.E. Dr. Adnan MANSOUR, Minister of Foreign Affairs and Emigrants of Lebanon, allow me extend to you our sincere appreciation for contributing to the successful conclusion of the 2MSP held in Beirut, from 12 to 16 September 2011. The Convention continues to grow and with recent ratifications and accessions, 68 States are now Parties to the Convention.

You will recall that States Parties to the Convention decided to meet again informally in advance of the Third Meeting of States Parties (3MSP) scheduled for September 2012 in Oslo, Norway to further discuss matters pertaining to the progress in implementing the Convention as a means to prepare for the 3MSP.
